

1. Parking, Shuttle (if needed), Warm-Up, Check-in begins one hour before start time.
2. Shuttle by golf cart may be provided from overflow parking area to courts.
3. Tournament will be played on outdoor courts. Not wheelchair accessible. No seating available, bring lawn chairs. A few shade canopies will be provided.
4. Boards and bags will be provided and must be used by all participants.
5. All Women, and Men 80 and over, may throw from 25' or 27'. Men 50-79 must throw from 27'. Distance measured from front of board to front of board.
6. Warm-up will be available before the competition begins. Once competition has begun, participants may take four practice throws before each game of play, if desired.
7. A double elimination tournament is planned. Everyone is guaranteed at least two games. A game will be a maximum of 8 frames or the first person to score 21 points. If the score is tied after 8 frames, an additional frame will be played to break the tie. The Event Manager reserves the right to change the format.
8. For the sake of time, the person who throws first will be determined by first names in alphabetical order. A frame is defined as when both players have thrown their 4 bags. Bags will be thrown alternately by each player until all 8 bags have been thrown.
9. One point shall be awarded per bag on the board. 3 points for every bag that is thrown or knocked into the hole.
Cancellation scoring will be used.
10. A bag that comes into contact with the ground before the board is not a legal throw and will be removed from play and point consideration. A bag that is touching the ground while also sitting on the board will also be removed from play and point consideration. A bag must completely clear the hole to be in the hole. A bag hanging partially in the hole is a bag on board, not in the hole.
11. All bags are scored depending on where they are after all 8 bags have been thrown. Sometimes, the bags are pushed off the boards or slide into the hole after they are thrown. Scoring is calculated on the final spot of the bags whether it be on the board or in the hole.
12. The following actions shall be considered fouls:
 - a. Thrower stepping on or over the foul line – the line extending parallel to the front of the board.
 - b. Thrower throws out of turn.
 - c. When alternating turns, a player tosses his/her bag before the previously thrown bag comes to rest.
 - d. Throwing outside the thrower's box which is defined as an area running from the front to the back of the board extending out 3 feet from the side of the board.
13. The following penalties shall be assessed for fouls.
 - a. One foul: warning and opponent chooses to have a re-throw or not.
 - b. Subsequent fouls after warning: Loss of turn, bag is removed from that frame's scoring.
14. Bag Toss is an "open" event at the Florida Senior Games.
