
GPS directions to Central Florida Archers, Fort Meade, FL are generally not helpful. Please use these: From Lakeland, Bartow, Winter Haven: Take Hwy 17 South from Bartow. Begin mileage from only traffic light in Fort Meade, continue south on Hwy 17 for approximately 3.5 miles. Use landmark of Camp Wilderness on left (east) side of hwy. At 2nd opportunity, cross median in a U turn. Central Florida Archers sign and gate will be on east side of road. Look for Polk Senior Games signs. From Bowling Green: Take Hwy 17 North from Polk/Hardee County line for approximately 3.5 miles. Central Florida Archers sign and gate will be on your right on the east side of Hwy 17. Look for Polk Senior Games signs.

3D ARCHERY ADDITIONAL RULES

revised 10/6/2025

- 1. 3D Archery is a new event in 2026. Participants will compete in one of the following categories: Finger, Compound Release, Recurve, or Barebow Recurve. Category will be determined at check-in. The event is limited to 50 shooters.
- 2. Participants must provide their own bows and target arrows. Bows must conform to FITA rules in the Recurve event. Compound bows may not exceed 80 pounds draw weight and arrow speed may not exceed 300 feet per second plus or minus 3 percent. No broadheads will be permitted. Field glasses or scopes are permitted for spotting arrow hits.
- 3. 30 Delta Mckenzie 3D animal targets WILL BE USED.
- 4. Compound shooters will have a max distance of 40 yards and will shoot from the red stake. (5 40 yards) Recurve / barebow shooters will have a max distance of 25 yards and will shoot from the blue stake. (5 25 yards).
- 5. Scoring will consist of 12, 10, 8, 5. The 14 ring is not in play and will be scored as an 8 if hit. The upper 12 ring is not in play and will be scored as a 10 if hit. Any arrow that misses the target will be scored as a zero. The arrow only needs to touch the scoring line for the score to be counted. It does not need to break the line. Scoring Diagram:



- 6. Archers will be placed into groups of 4 and assigned a target number to begin shooting.
- 7. One arrow per archer will be shot at each 3D animal. All four archers will shoot before approaching the target to score and retrieve arrows. Once arrows are pulled, archers proceed to the next target identified by a blue sign numbered 1-30.
- 8. If there are any questions during the event, a range official will be present on the course and identified by an orange safety vest.
- 9. Each archer will get two scorecards and each group will have two archers recording scores, one archer pulling arrows, and one archer calling where the arrows land on the target. Scorecards will be provided by Central Florida Archers Inc and will be provided the morning of the event.
- 10. Any ties will be broken by the number of 12's shot.
- 11. National Archery Association (www.usarchery.org), National Field Archery Association (www.nfaa-archery.org) and Florida Archery Association (www.floridaarchery.org) rules apply, except as modified.
