- 1 Shooters may enter any or all of three categories:
 - Centerfire Pistol, Iron Sights, barrel 5 inches or less
 Centerfire Pistol, Optical Sights, barrel 5 inches or less
 22 Rimfire, any sights, barrel 3 inches or less. (a .22 **carry gun** is permitted. Olympic style target guns are NOT accepted. Dedicated target pistols are discouraged.)
- 2. Medals are awarded for men and women in 10 year age groups; 50-59, 60-69, 70-79, 80-89, etc.
- 3. Notification of start time will be mailed. If notification is not received, call Event Manager Hal Hare at 863-583-4858. Also, call Hal if unable to attend after receiving start time.
- 4. A MANDATORY safety and review meeting will be held 15 minutes before your group's start time. You can only attend YOUR group's safety meeting to enter the range and compete. As safety is a priority, pistol shooting participants MUST have prior experience.
- 5. Shooters must provide their own ammunition and concealed carry type pistol.
- 6. Equipment may be inspected and participation denied if equipment is deemed not safe.
- 7. Firearms used for competition may not be shared with another shooter on same relay.
- 8. Eye and hearing protection is required.
- 9. Any unsafe behavior will be grounds for disqualification.
- 10. Courtesy and safety are mandatory. No loud talking on or behind firing line is allowed.
- 11. No practice targets or practice shooting before the match.
- 12. Each match consists of 30 shots fired in three stages:
 - 1) Slow Fire, 10 shots (loading 5 shells at a time) at 10 yards in 5 minutes
 - 2) Timed Fire, 2 separate 5 shot strings at 5 yards, 20 seconds per string
 - 3) Rapid Fire, 2 separate 5 shot strings at 5 yards, 10 seconds per string
- 13. B-29 silhouette targets will be used.
- 14. Ties will be broken using "X" ring hits
- 15. Range Rules
 - a. Pistols must remain cased or boxed until you reach your assigned firing lane
 - b. Do not load your pistol until you receive the command to "LOAD" from the Range Master
 - c. Do not load more than 5 shells at a time, regardless of your pistols capacity
 - d. There will be no ALIBI shots permitted for gun or ammo malfunctions.
 - e. When you finish a stage, remove your magazine an lock your slide back or open your revolver's cylinder.
 - f. Spectators must remain in the lobby or lounge.
