- 1. A facility fee of \$15 must be paid when registering. Participants choose one event: Compound Finger, Compound Release, Recurve, Barebow Recurve, or **3D.** Events will run simultaneously.
- 2. There will be a limit of 50 shooters in Compound Finger, Compound Release, Recurve, and Barebow Recurve, A "600" round will be used for all competition. 60 arrows will be shot as follows: 20 arrows (4 ends of 5 arrows) from distances of 60, 50 & 40 yards. Tie breaker will be the highest number of "X" ring hits; then "10", then "9" etc.
- 3. New Event: 3D Archery There will be a limit of 50 shooters in 3D Archery. Compound shooters will have a max distance of 40 yards. Recurve/Barebow shooters will have a max of distance of 25 yards. Ties will be broken by the numbers of "12's" shot. Categories, determined at check-in. are: Compound Finger, Compound Release, Recurve, Barebow Recurve. Events will run simultaneously.
- 4. Participants must provide their own bows and target arrows. Bows must conform to FITA rules in the Recurve event. Compound bows may not exceed 80 pounds draw weight and arrow speed may not exceed 300 feet per second plus or minus 3 percent. No broadheads will be permitted. Field glasses or scopes are permitted for spotting arrow hits.
- 5. Lawn chairs and bug repellent are suggested.
- 6. National Archery Association (usarchery.org), National Field Archery Association (nfaa-archery.org) and Florida Archery Association (floridaarchery.org) rules apply, except as modified.
